Stop Deportations in Barnim!

Fear instead of welcome?

This year, there were many deportations and attempts to deport people from Barnim. People who are seeking protection on their flight should feel safe here! However, many of the refugees in Barnim are living in fear. Some of them don't sleep in their rooms anymore, because they are afraid of getting deported during the night.

On April 3 at 4 am, employees of the Ausländerbehörde Barnim woke up a man from Chad who was living at the Heim in Bernau-Lobetal. They brought him directly to a plane in Berlin, which deported him to France. There he is threatened by a deportation to Chad, one of the world's poorest countries, where according to Amnesty International massive violations of human rights take place. This deportation was very frightening for the other residents of the Heim because they could also be deported.

Another man from Chad panicked and jumped out of a window in fear, fell through a glass roof and suffered from serious injuries.

We demand of the Landrat of Barnim Bodo Ihrke and the head of the Ausländerbehörde Barnim Ilka Zerche-Roch an immediate deportation stop! Advocate this on a state level and a national level as well! Put an end to the atmosphere of fear!
